- 4. <u>The War That Saved My Life</u> by Kimberly Brubaker Bradley

Book Choice Board

After reading your book, create a picture book version of the story. (Include the most important events from the book and illustrate them in order.) It must be in color and look like a book.	Imagine your book is being made into a movie. Create a movie poster that includes visuals and a summary of the book. Give the book a star rating (4 stars is the best, 1 star is not so great). It must be in color.
Create a t-shirt which represents the book. Prepare a book talk which goes with the t-shirt (your book talk should include a summary of the book, favorite parts and why the class should (or should not) read the book. You will present your book talk (and show off your t-shirt) to the rest of the class.	Imagine the book had a hidden scene (In any part of the story).Write the scene as it would fit into the book. TWO page minimum.

Projects require PIRR, so make sure it reflects your best work, it is neat and shows you put forth effort. This is your first chance to make a good impression! This will count as your very first test grade.
